STCW A-VI/4-1

SCOPE:

The Medical First Aid course has been designed to meet the requirements of the STCW Convention 1978, as amended, Table A-VI/4-1.

OBJECTIVE:

Those who successfully complete this course should achieve the required standard of competence to apply immediate first aid in the event of accident or illness on board, identify and treat medical emergencies, treat dislocations, fractures,.. Etc.

COURSE CONTENT:

- Immediate action and first aid kit;
- Body structure and functions;
- Toxicological hazards aboard ship;
- Examination of patient and medical care of rescued persons, including distress, hypothermia and cold exposure;
- Spinal injuries, burns, scalds, effects of heat and cold, fractures, dislocations and muscular injuries;
- Radio medical advice;
- Pharmacology;
